
## Call for Art

At least 20 artists will be selected to be included in this volume, the decisions of the review committee are final. If your work is selected to be included you will receive the following benefits.

- Your work will be published and promoted to a wide audience around the country
- Each artist be identified, acknowledged and will have a short bio (50 words or less) & website info
- You will know that you are supporting the preservation of our pollinators
- You will be a part of supporting the arts in the Chugach region.

Deadline for submission has been extended to: May 15, 2013

Books will be available for sale on line by June 1 in time for Pollinator Week June 17-23, 2013
